Motion by Rebhuhn; seconded by Hays at approve the first reading of Board Policy 411.2 Classified Employee Qualifications, Recruitment, Selection with the policy to read that the superintendent has the authority to hire, without board approval, bus drivers, custodians, education associates, maintenance staff, clerical personnel, school nurses and food service workers. The superintendent also has the authority to sign these contracts. Motion carried (3-1). Clausen voting may.

Board policies 501.14 and 501.15 relating to Open Enrollment Procedures was withdrawn from consideration.
