Motion by Clausen; seconded by Bruns to purchase new science curriculum as proposed at a cost not to exceed \$5,628.54. Motion carried (4 - 0).

Motion by Hays; seconded by Clausen to offer an extended contract to Annette Benedict as Special Education instructor to teach summer school for an eligible special needs student at her per diem rate, plus mileage. Motion carried (4 - 0).

Motion by Hays; seconded by Clausen to appoint Kim Ellrich to serve as elementary secretary at a wage of \$7.25 per hour, beginning July 7, 2008. Motion carried (3 - 1). (Bruns: Nay, Clausen, Hays, and Moens: Aye)

Tabled until July 14, 2008 board meeting - Transition Plan for Board Members.

Motion by Clausen; seconded by Hays to amend the superintendent's contract to include 130 days of service with a minimum of 60 days in the office paid per diem at the same rate as 2007-08, with ten additional days, if needed, and compensate the remaining days of service by providing individual health insurance under the district's plan. Motion carried (4-0).

Motion by Hays; seconded by Clausen to adjourn. Motion carried (4 - 0). Meeting adjourned at 8:55 p.m.
