Motion by Clausen; seconded by Buse to adopt the 2009 -10 school calendar as presented. Motion carried (3 - 0).

Motion by Clausen; seconded by Buse to increase the request for allowable growth for at-risk programs to 70,188 for fiscal year 2009-10. Motion carried (3 - 0).

Motion by Clausen; seconded by Buse to approve the following resolution. Be It Resolved, that the Board of Directors of the Albert City-Truesdale community school district will levy property tax for fiscal year 2009 -10 for the regular budget adjustment as allowed under Iowa Code section 257.14. Motion carried (3 - 0). The board discussed plans for the district in relation to buildings, grounds and transportation, academic and activity program issues and concerns for the 2009 - 2010 school year. Bruns joined the meeting telephonically at 6:25pm to take part in the work session relating to finances.

Motion by Bruns; seconded by Clausen to direct the administration to reduce 2009 - 2010 projected General fund expenditures 140,000 - 175,000 gross of salary increases. Motion carried (4 - 0).
