Major educational needs discussed - recruiting and maintaining qualified teachers, providing up to date curriculum in reading, math, and science, STEM exposure, and maintaining improved facilities.

FAST testing data was shared of proficient and non-proficient from Winter 2023 and Winter 2024..

K-6 Reading - 2023- 55% proficient 2024 - 64% proficient
Math - 2023 - 57% proficient 2024 - 65% proficient

Reviewed ISASP data for 2023 - 3-6 summary

Math 2023 - Reading 75% proficient Math - 68% proficient. Science - 5th grade only 25% proficient

For 2024 we set the goal to increase proficiency in reading, math, and science.

Set goals for growth on FAST - increased proficiency by Spring testing window.

Reviewed harassment and bullying and set goals for next year. No founded cases of bullying or harassment in 2022-23 and none so far this year. Discussed implementing behavior program similar to PBIS for the 2024-25 school year.
