


Word finding puzzles were invented by Norman E. Gibat. Norman lived in Oklahoma. In 1968, he was researching methods on how to get readers to interact more with his publication known as Selenby Digest. This was the beginning of word search puzzles. He wanted to make a word finding problem simple and straightforward enough to be able to be quickly played while people were sitting in a waiting room or standing in line at a grocery store.

The word finding puzzles that Gibat created turned out to be very successful. Teachers quickly realized how much education was behind these word retrieval puzzles and began figuring out ways on how to bring them in the classroom.

News of these word retrieval problems spread like wildfire, and teachers from different states began inquiring about using the word finding puzzles that Gibat created.
